A copy of the Floor Plan for the basement of the One-Stop Center has been located and appears on the following page. It is taken from the clearest plan that could be found.

It should be noted, however, that the entirety of the basement is dedicated to Great Oaks Career Campus and CCMEP/Community Link (Talbert House), both of whom are signatories to the Memorandum of Understanding, which is included under Addendum 3, and are therefore OSO partners under the MOU.

Great Oaks operates entry level healthcare programs that can be followed by state-tested certifications lab spaces and classroom spaces of the lower level. Talbert House operates Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program (CCMEP) and Community Link(TANF) programming as well in the lower level. CCMEP was developed under Governor Kasich's refocus of TANF into employment programming and has been considered for inclusion in the TANF reauthorization efforts.

The Floor Plans provided show current usage under the SWORWIB's investments with upgrading the 45,000 Sq.ft. of the OMJ Center (currently the State of Ohio's one stop centers are known as OhioMeansJobs/OMJ Centers. Proposals that include physical space restructuring should consider not including the lower level in these considerations.
